Catechesis Corner

The Jesus Prayer

O Lord, Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me a sinner.

This month we are turning our focus to a specific prayer. The Jesus Prayer is a very simple prayer that has been around for centuries and has often been noted to be one of the most essential basic prayers for Eastern Christians, however this prayer can be beneficial for any Christian wanting to achieve a true relationship with God.

The Jesus Prayer according to numerous Church Fathers is "essential" to our spiritual growth. The Jesus Prayer is thought to be as old as the Church itself.

The Jesus Prayer, helps us to be able to *stand in God's presence*. This means that the Jesus Prayer helps us to focus our mind exclusively on God with no other thought occupying our mind but the thought of God. At this moment when our mind is totally concentrated on God, we discover a very personal and direct relationship with Him.

The Jesus Prayer has two important purposes. The first is **worship** as with all prayer. The second is a **discipline** to help our soul gain control of our overactive brains and create stillness so the Holy Spirit can work through us and help us live the virtues in union with God.

To start praying the Jesus Prayer, It is best to add the Jesus Prayer to your morning prayers as this is when the mind is the quietest. Begin by saying the Jesus Prayer verbally focusing on each word. If you want, start by only repeating a couple times slowly or use a small chotky, which is 33 times. You will experience the challenge of dealing with your thoughts, the tendency for you mind to wander. Attention when praying the Jesus Prayer is important. Be sincere in your prayer and repeat it with contrition. Praying the Jesus Prayer is that simple, but it does take patience and practice to achieve the ideal way of praying it.

At the entrance of each parish, there are brochures to help learn more about this prayer. Also available are 'chotky.' Chotky are the special prayer ropes that are used for praying the Jesus Prayer, much like a rosary is used for. If you do not have chotky, you can actually use your rosary too. If you wish to have your own set of chotky, sign up at the back of the church and Fr. Jay will personally make them for you.
