Catechesis Corner

Our next series in Catechesis Corner will be focusing on the Divine Liturgy and what it all means through the various elements of the service. These reflections are taken from the book titled, "Serve the Lord with Gladness" by a Monk of the Eastern Church. Our hope is that we grow in our understanding and appreciation of the Divine Liturgy and that these reflections will help us to pray better.

Blessed Among Women

At this point in the liturgy, the priest mentions all those in whom Pentecost has been visibly manifested, that is, the saints who constitute the glorified, heavenly Church.

The icons remind us that the saints are present with us and take part in our worship. At the moment of the Lesser Entrance we requested that the angels and the saints enter with us into the sanctuary. Now this commemoration of the saints becomes more specific. The priest calls to remembrance the patriarchs and prophets of the Old Testament, the apostles, evangelists, martyrs, confessors (those persecuted for the faith), ascetics, and all righteous departed. And he mentions "especially our most holy, most pure, most blessed and glorious Mother of God and ever-virgin Mary."

The choir replies by singing: "It is truly meet to bless you, O Theotokos ['Birth-giver of God'], everblessed and most pure, and the Mother of our God. More honorable than the Cherubim, and more glorious beyond compare than the Seraphim,' she who "gave birth to God the Word," remaining ever a Virgin.

We glorify Mary not only because of the unique privilege that was accorded to her. She was a humble servant of the Lord, asking only that it should be done to her according to the word of the Angel at the Annun-ciation. She heard and kept in her heart the words of her Son. And she surrounds us with a silent tenderness, always attentive to our needs, compassionately interceding for us. A trusting and loving intimacy with her brings into our life refreshment, calmness, and hope.



Vibrant Parish

New-used liturgical items in Rossburn!

Some of you may have noticed some new items over the last couple months in Sacred Heart parish in Rossburn. As we continue to beautify the already exceptional place of worship, we'd like to thank the many people and places that these items came from.

- Main icons with royal doors: these icon stands and doors were originally built by Fr. John Sianchuk C.Ss.R. for St. Joseph Parish in Winnipeg. After they installed a permanent iconostasis, these icons moved to St. Anne Parish in Winnipeg. After their permanent iconostasis was installed, these sat in storage until they were given to Sacred Heart Parish. We thank Fr. Mark Gnutel for passing these on!
- Artophorion (tabernacle): This tabernacle was originally purchased back in 1966 for the parish in Cudworth, SK. They recently closed down, and the tabernacle was put into storage in Saskatoon. Fr. Jay acquired this back in February and was a beautiful modification to our altar.
- Candelabra: It is customary in Slavic churches to have a 7candle candelabra set behind the tabernacle. We thank the anonymous donor who provided us with this beautiful candelabra.
- Lampada: A candle in front of an icon is important to reveal the light of Christ within each icon. We thank Donna Marie Yaskiw who donated the lampada candles hanging on the iconostasis.
