A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR: I would just like to give a reminder that when approaching for Holy Communion, you do not need to do anything fancy or special, especially if you are shorter than me, but also if you are taller than me. Simply cross yourself, step up close to the chalice, cross your hands over your chest, and lean your head back and open your mouth wide like at the dentist. There is no need to lunge, bend over, or crouch. Also, keep your tongue in, but open wide your mouth. Please also, do your best to not close your mouth around the spoon. We no longer use tongue depressors here, so we don't have to do that anymore. Following this will help keep your balance and ensure that we are not dropping the Holy Eucharist.
